Requirements

Two years continuous sobriety One year of active service in C.A.

<u>Term</u>

Two year commitment

<u>Attendance</u>

- If the Chair must be absent, he/she must ensure the Vice-Chair will be present at the SABA meeting
- In order to maintain one's service position one must not miss two (2) consecutive SABA meetings (or more than 25% of the meetings in one's term) and must submit one's written report regardless of attendance/absence
- Attendance is defined as being physically present at the SABA business meeting with a written report ready to be given to the SABA body
- Defaulting on attendance requirements will result in dismissal from one's service position

Responsibilities

- Presides over the SABA meeting and arranges agenda.
- Only votes in the case of a tie (when chairing)
- Assumes responsibilities of coordinating / supporting all activities within the Area
- Encourages trusted servants to chair various standing committees
