Requirements

1 year continuous sobriety
6 months of active service experience in C.A.

Term

2 year commitment

Attendance

- In order to maintain one's service position one must not miss two (2) consecutive SABA meetings (or more than 25% of the meetings in one's term) and must submit one's written report regardless of attendance/absence
- Attendance is defined as being physically present at the SABA business meeting with a written report ready to be given to the SABA body
- Either the Chair or Alternate Chair of each standing committee must be present at every SABA business meeting
- Defaulting on attendance requirements will result in dismissal from one's service position

Responsibilities

- Teaches the roles and responsibilities required of the Unity position to the Alternate Chair
- The Unity Committee Chair works in cooperation with the Alternate Chair to fulfill the duties listed below:
 - Provides a report at each SABA meeting about Unity issues and events in each District
 - Responsible for the communication and outreach among the diverse elements within the C.A. fellowship at all levels in the interest of carrying the C.A. message
 - It is also suggested that these committees sponsor annual workshops and other forums to promote SABA C.A. unity
 - The SABA C.A. Unity committee works in coordination with the SABA C.A. Entertainment committee specifically and any other pertinent SABA C.A. standing committee when organizing fellowship events or communicating unifying information throughout the fellowship.

This Service Guide is intended for Southern Alberta Area-level service members.
